Also, high in calcium, an important mineral for calming nerves.

- Passionflower Leaf (*Passiflora incarnata*) has effective sedative and tranquilizing qualities. It has a positive effect on blood pressure levels, reduces anxiousness, and has an anti-inflammatory action on nerves and tissues.

- Chamomile Flower (*Matricaria recutita*) calms and soothes both the digestive and nervous systems. This herb is rich in calcium and magnesium salts, helping to relax the nervous system. It has anti-inflammatory, antispasmodic, and sedative actions, and reduces stomach upsets and gas.

- Skullcap Leaf/Stem/Flower (*Scutellaria lateriflora*) is one of the best herbs for nerves. It reduces anxiousness and nervousness, and is somewhat sedating. High in mineral content, it is also anti-inflammatory and supports liver function and the digestive system.

- Hops Strobile (*Humulus lupulus*), an aromatic bitter herb, has a sedating nervine effect that is relaxing and healing to the nervous system. It also helps to reduce spasms in the muscles, soothes the stomach and helps blood pressure levels to normalize.

- Valerian Root (*Valeriana officinalis*) is known as “nature’s tranquilizer.” It has a strong sedating effect on the nervous system without side effects like drugs have. It is widely used in Europe for a wide variety of nervous conditions, for reducing sleep problems, irritability, and for general stress reduction. This herb is also beneficial for balancing blood pressure levels.

- mB!™ is a proprietary micro-fractionated liquid trace mineral supplement that assists important enzymatic processes essential to physical and emotional responses to stress.
