Simply put, this formula improves your horse's health while gently helping to reduce internal parasites and makes the digestive tract less attractive to parasites. An added benefit is that not only does this product have strong parasite clearing actions, it also calms many horses down! A parasite cleanse requires three steps for completion:

Equine Parasite Management is best given on a relatively empty stomach. May also be used externally as a wash for antiseptic and insect repellent purposes. Dilute with water to desired strength.

NOTE: Do not give to pregnant horses.
