The herbs in Equine Wet Respiratory Aid by Cedar Bear Naturales™ work together to effectively cool and soothe raw respiratory tissues as they help to remove excess mucus and congestion. This formula causes an expectorant (deep coughing) action to help clear congestion and phlegm and is specifically formulated for reducing excess respiratory congestion. It helps clear cold/allergy symptom-based coughs by making them more productive and by helping to dry up respiratory tissues.

**CONTAINS:** White pine bark, chokecherry bark, spikenard root, elecampane root, European elder berry, licorice root and cinnamon bark in a Kosher certified glycerin/purified water TincTract® base.

**NOTE:** This product should not be used for dry, hacking, hoarse coughs. Use Equine Respiratory Aid for Dry Conditions instead. Not recommended for pregnant animals.

**SUGGESTED USE:** 1/2 to 1 teaspoon for a medium size horse every 30 to 60 minutes until crisis abates, then 2 to 3 times a day until symptoms go away.

### MORE ABOUT THE HERBS IN THIS FORMULA:

- White Pine Bark (*Pinus strobus*) has an astringing action that helps to tone respiratory tissues and clear out endotoxic residue from the body and creates an expectorant response.

- Chokecherry Bark (*Prunus serotina*) is an astringing, cooling and drying expectorant for the respiratory tract that removes excess mucus and congestion in the respiratory system by initially causing a deep coughing reflex that is fol-

lowed by a relaxing of the upper respiratory muscles. This herb soothes irritated throats and is also mildly stimulating to the digestive system, helping it to work better to clear out congestion in the body.

- Spikenard Root (*Aralia racemosa*) is a reflex expectorant, and helps to soothe inflamed tissues and move excess fluids from the respiratory tract. This herb is generally used for cold-like symptoms, chronic coughs and bronchial spasms.

- Elecampane Root (*Inula helenium*) is a respiratory relaxant that helps reduce chronic respiratory symptoms and coughs and loosens up stubborn phlegm. It has an antiseptic action and is mildly diuretic, helping to pull excess fluids from the body. It builds liver function and stimulates digestion while calming and soothing jumpy stomachs.

- European Elder Berry (*Sambucus nigra*) contains respiratory-specific antiseptic flavonoid components, is high in mineral ascorbates and vitamin C mineral electrolytes, and helps to reduce coughs, bronchial and sinus congestion, and fevers. It has a distinct anti-inflammatory action in the body. Elderberry is a favorite remedy for clearing phlegm, as an expectorant for coughs, and as a diuretic.

- Licorice Root (*Glycyrrhiza glabra*) works as an expectorant that reduces inflammation, helps reduce cold symptoms, coughs and bronchial problems, soothes mucous membranes, irritated lungs and sore throats, and helps mucus to clear from respiratory tissues. This herb is high in B vitamins.

- Cinnamon Bark (*Cinnamomum cassia*) has antiseptic and astringing action and improves immunity, helping the body to overcome phlegmatic coughs. It helps reduce gas and indigestion, and is good for "cold" conditions.
